

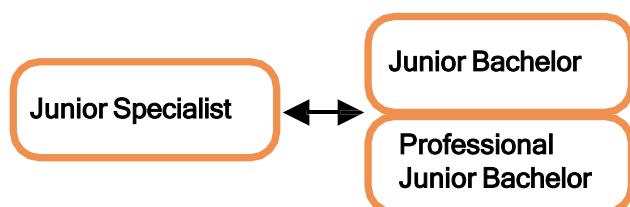
# Qualifications from Ukraine

The Directorate for Further Education and Skills has two general authorisation schemes for applicants from Ukraine:

### The Directorate of Higher Education and Skills considers:

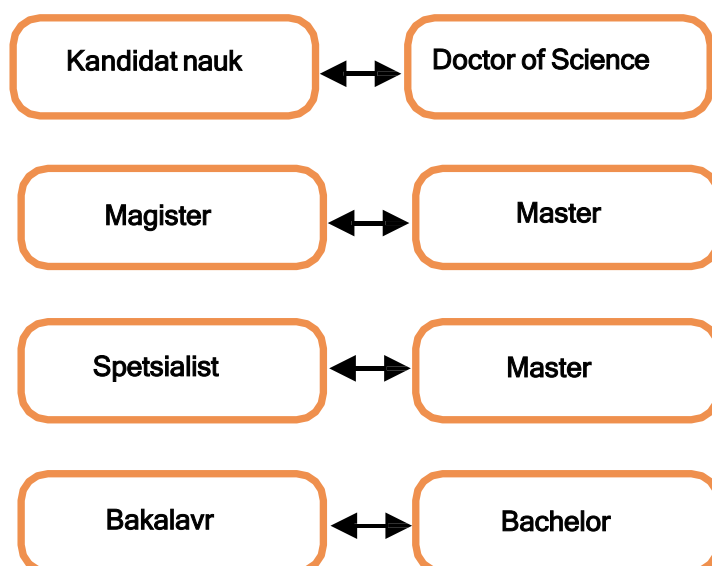
- Junior Specialist/Junior Bachelor/Professional Junior Bachelor to be equal in level and scope to a accredited Norwegian vocational college education.
- Education with integrated secondary education is partially recognised.

\* The years are not absolute. The reform began in 2014, but its implementation was gradual. The last intake for Spetsialist was in 2016, and the last intake for Molodshy spetsialist (Junior Specialist) was in 2019.

### Final documentation

Institutions may issue certificates in different sizes and colours using different materials.

### Directorate of further education and skills:

- **Bakalavr 3 years.** Recognised as equal to a Norwegian university college degree
- **Bakalavr 4 years.** Authorised as equal to a Norwegian Bachelor degree
- **Magister/Spetsialist 1. year.** Recognised as equal to a Norwegian Master's degree of one year length (shorter Master's degree)
- **Magister/Spetsialist 1.5 – 2 yrs.** Recognised as equal to a shorter Norwegian Master's degree of the same length.
- **Magister/Spetsialist 5 yrs.** Recognised as equal to a Norwegian Bachelor degree and a shorter Norwegian Master's degree
- **Magister/Spetsialist 5.5 – 6 yrs.** Recognised as equal to a Norwegian integrated Master's degree
- **Kandidate nauk/Doctor of Science**  
Recognised as equal to a Norwegian Doctorate /Ph.D.
